ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES

FORWARD

MICHIGAN'S ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES WERE BUILT BETWEEN 1835 & 1900, AND BY 1900 THERE WERE 153 SCHOOLHOUSES IN VAN BUREN COUNTY.

THE FIRST SCHOOL IN VAN BUREN COUNTY WAS HELD IN THE LOG HOUSE OF DOPHIN MORRIS, VAN BUREN COUNTY'S FIRST SETTLER. WILLIAM ALEXANDER WAS THE TEACHER

THE FIRST SCHOOLHOUSE IN VAN BUREN COUNTY WAS BUILT IN PAW PAW ON GREMPS STREET IN 1836. SCHOOLHOUSES WERE OFTEN THE FIRST PUBLIC BUILDING TO BE BUILT IN A COMMUNITY AND MOST WERE ALSO USED FOR SOCIAL, RELIGIOUS, AND POLITICAL MEETINGS.

BY 1935, IT WAS CLEAR THAT VAN BUREN COUNTY'S EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS WERE NO LONGER MEETING THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY. A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY RESULTED IN THE COUNTY SCHOOL MODERNIZATION PROGRAM. BY 1942, 90 ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES IN VAN BUREN COUNTY WERE IMPROVED AT A COST OF \$1,119.79 PER SCHOOLHOUSE.

ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES BEGAN TO DISAPPEAR IN THE 1930'S AND BY THE 1960'S MOST OF THEM WERE GONE.

TODAY THERE ARE SIXTEEN ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES IN MICHIGAN'S LOWER PENNINSULA. ONE OF THOSE IS NO. 6, KNOWN AS WOOD SCHOOL IN BANGOR TOWNSHIP

ABOUT THE ARTIST

PAW PAW DISTRICT LIBRARY IS FORTUNATE TO HAVE NINETEEN INK DRAWINGS OF FORMER COUNTY SCHOOL BUILDINGS DONE BY PAW PAW RESIDENT ARTIST PAT MILLER COY.

THE PROJECT PROVED TO BE A CHALLENGING ONE. IT WOULD TAKE PAT ALMOST ALL OF 1997 TO COMPLETE. MOST OF THE ONE-ROOM SCHOOLHOUSES THAT ONCE DOTTED THE LANDSCAPES OF ALMENA, ANTWERP, PAW PAW AND WAVERLY TOWNSHIPS HAD DISAPPEARED

WITH THE HELP OF OTHER LOCAL RESIDENTS, PAT WAS ABLE TO GATHER PHOTOS AND INFORMATION ABOUT THESE SCHOOLHOUSES THE INK DRAWINGS SEEN THROUGHOUT THE LIBRARY AND ON THIS WEBSITE ARE THE RESULT OF INTENSE RESEARCH AND EFFORT.

PAT HAS BEEN PART OF THE SOUTHWEST ARTIST'S ASSOCIATION SINCE IT'S BEGINNING. SHE HAS WON A PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD SEVERAL TIMES AT THE WINE AND HARVEST FESTIVAL. PAT HAS ALSO BEEN INVITED TO SHOW HER WORK AT STATE-WIDE AND NATIONAL EXHIBITS.

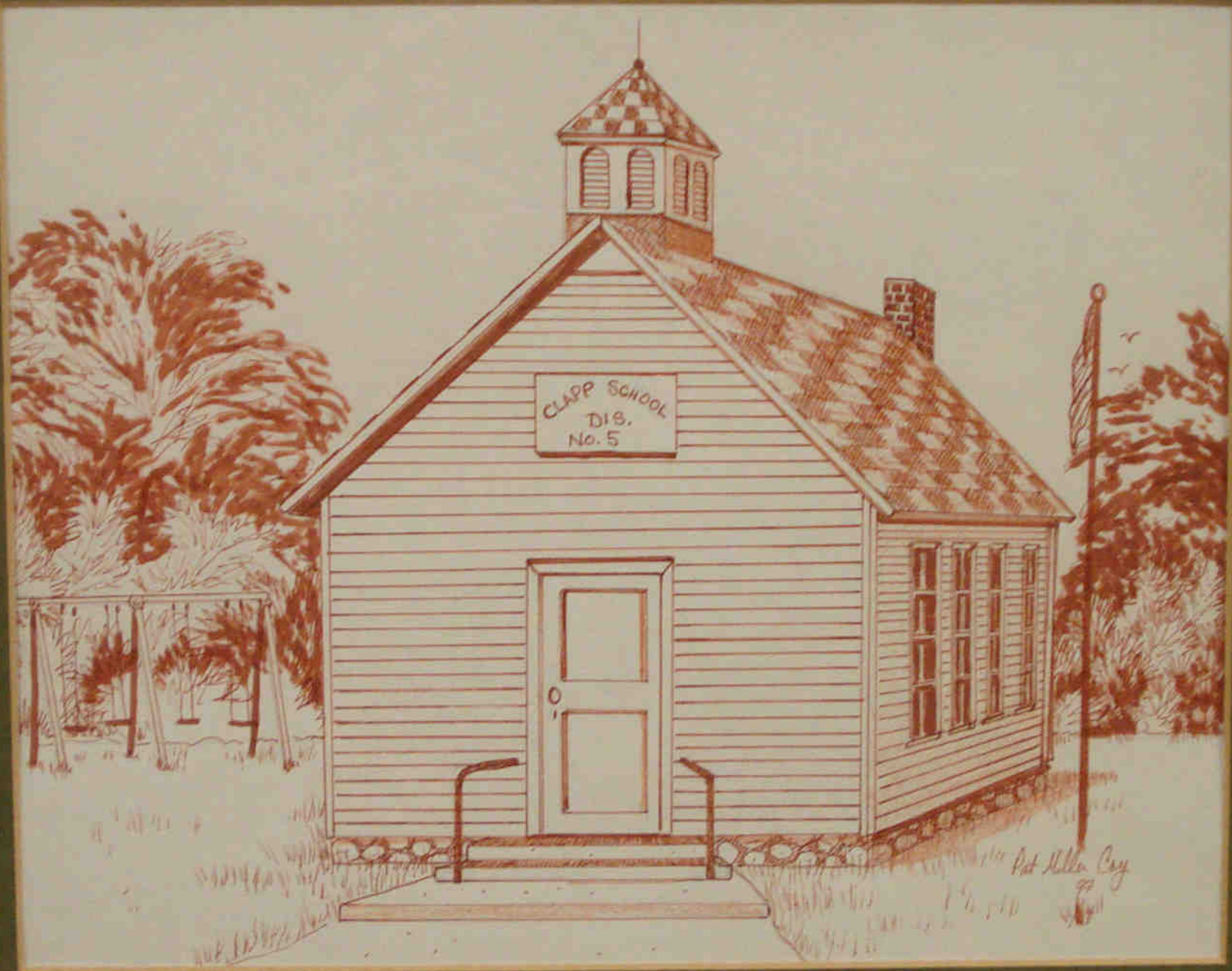

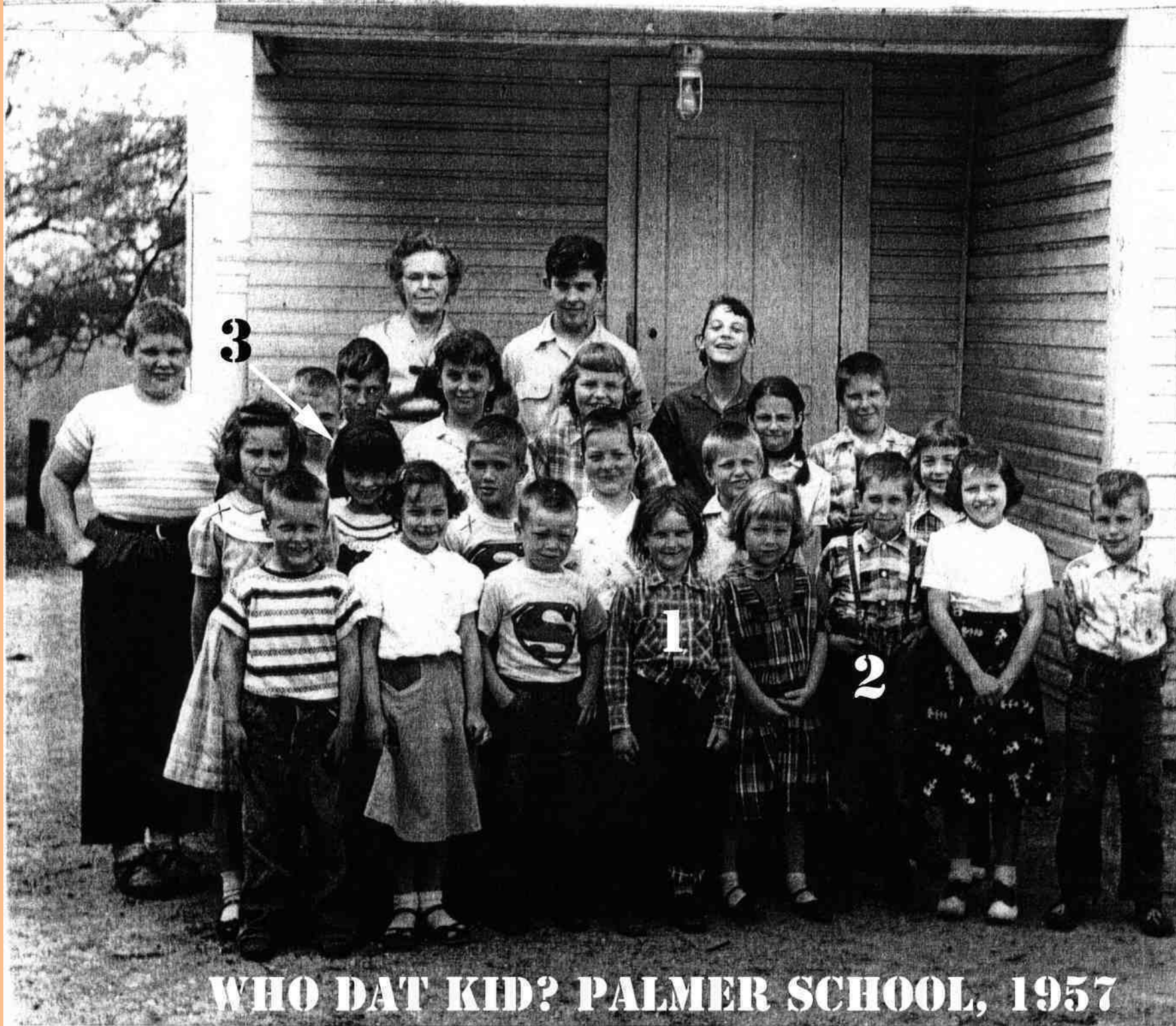

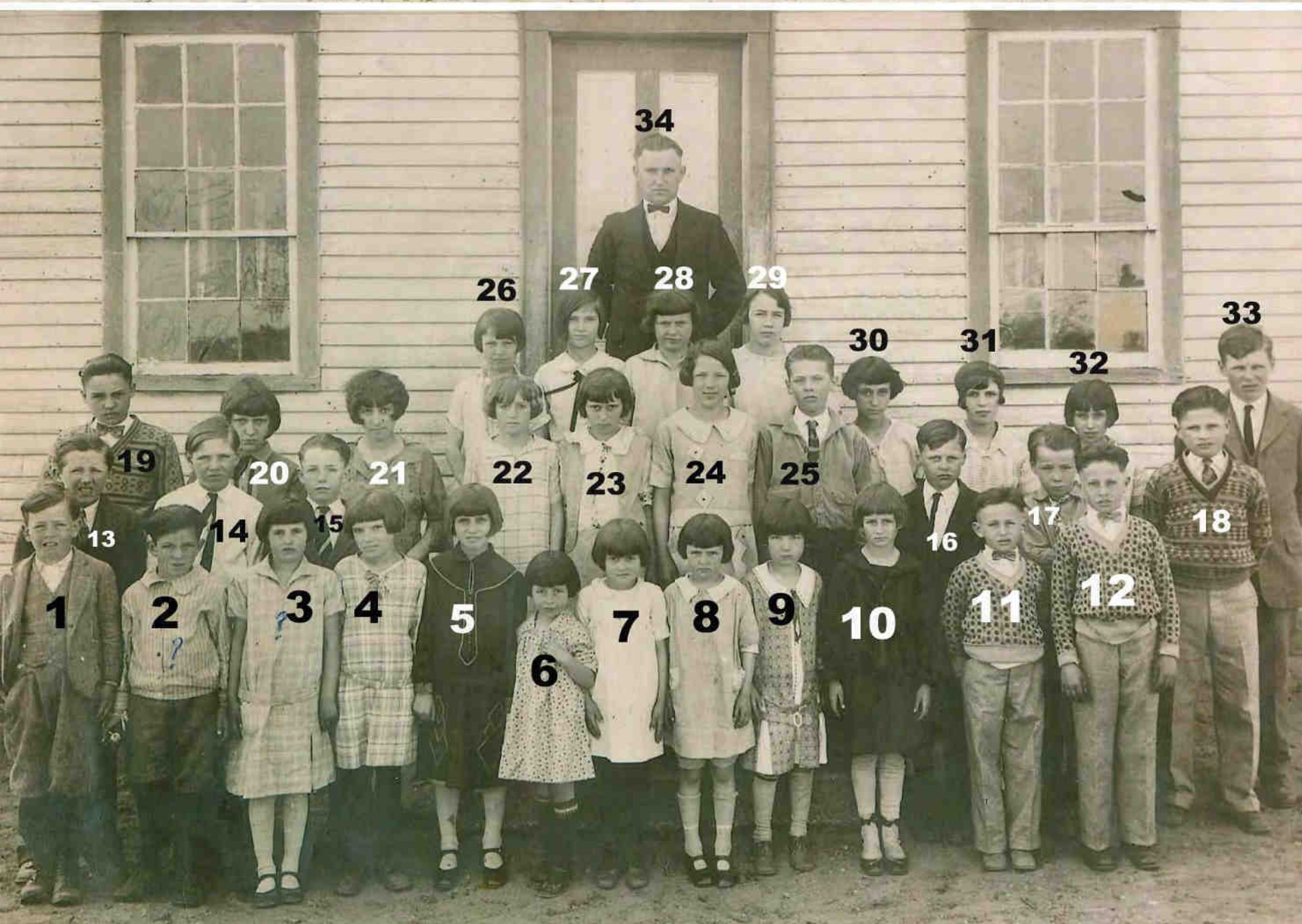

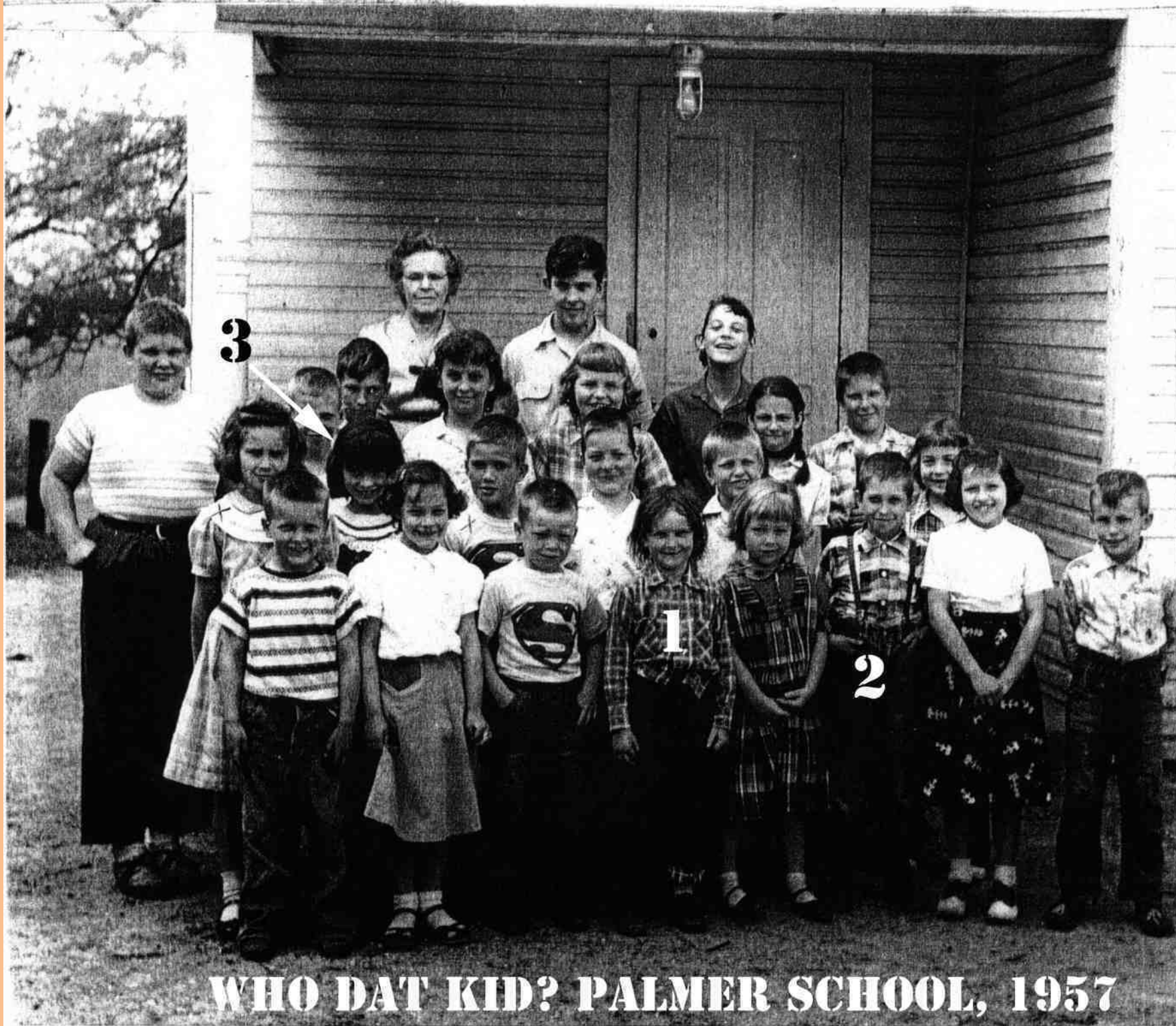

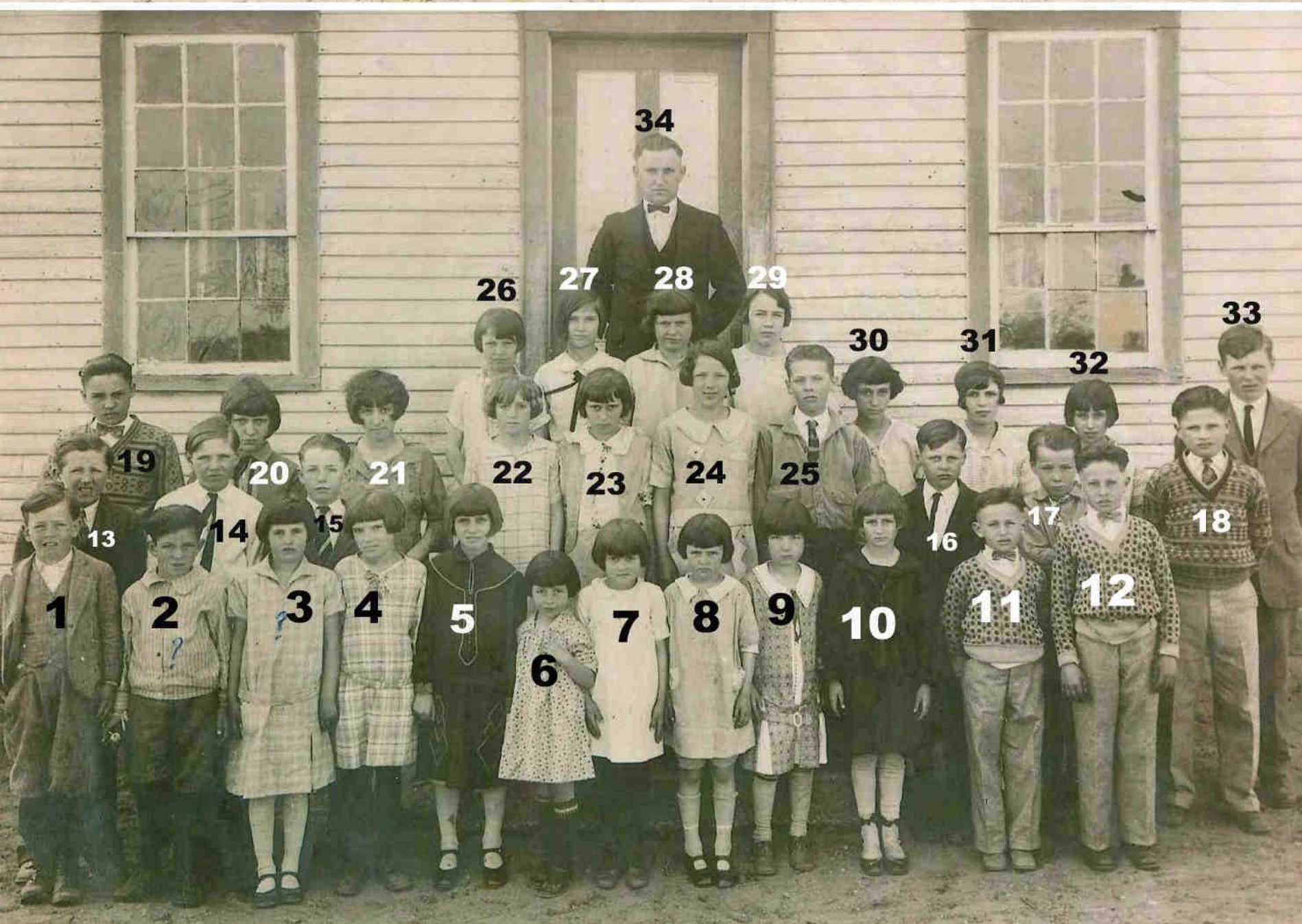
